

Wedding and Engagement FAQ's

How far in advance should I book our wedding?

Around 9 months is ideal, with 4-6 months being more of a minimum. Many of our clients even book closer to a year in advance to give them plenty of time for an engagement session and to order products from their session to be used for the wedding. However if your wedding is sooner than that- please don't hesitate to still request our availability!

What is the difference between high resolution and web resolution digital images?

High resolution images offer you the ability to view your images in very large formats at very high definition, as well as the ability to have them printed yourself or via another company at very large sizes. Web resolution images are sized specifically for viewing on your computer/tablet/smartphone and for sharing on social media sites and emails. They will print well up to a 4x6 if printed yourself or via another company, but no larger than that.

Do I really need an album or prints?

We **highly** encourage it, and here is why. It's not because we are trying to up sale you, or get you to purchase more. It's because we truly believe in telling your story, and preserving it in a real, tangible, and beautiful way. These products are more than just "add-on" items, they are your memories that will become heirlooms; able to be loved and enjoyed and passed down for years and years to come.
